Swiss company's advanced IT integration approach heralded by leading analyst firm **Butler Group endorses E2E's revolutionary MDI solution**

Basel, October 4th, 2006. E2E Technologies Ltd, the world's first company to offer software for fully Model Driven Integration (MDI), has received a very positive Technology Audit from the Butler Group, a leading provider of IT research, analysis and advice. Its key findings show clearly that E2E's unique MDI approach allows IT and business to collaborate more closely and that the high degree of automation allows integration projects to be completed in very short timescales and with extraordinarily high quality.

Butler Group points out that integration is a problem today faced by most organizations who have numerous databases and applications that need to interact with one another. So far, however, almost all tools aimed at the integration problem have been complex and expensive to deploy and maintain, with projects taking significant amounts of time and often still not achieving the desired objective. However, E2E Technologies' product, the E2E Bridge, is a radically different approach to integration, being based on the Object Management Group's (OMG) Model Driven Architecture (MDA) principles. It uses a service-oriented concept to model the integration requirements, and then executes the integration service model directly. This factor, highly praised by Butler, means that no code at all needs to be written and that the integration model itself becomes an effective communication tool between business and IT in its own right, since "analysts and developers can share the same model context rather than having separate specification and implementation models".

Furthermore, as Butler clearly states: "Direct model execution means that that the documentation "IS" the code, with no discrepancy between the original design and operational version of the development artifact; hence the documentation is always complete".

Here also, the intelligent use of a visual UML tool as development front-end vastly improves collaboration between business and IT, bringing "impressive speed of deployment on projects".

Butler Group concludes this favorable Technology Audit by re-emphasizing the core strength of the E2E philosophy and solutions: "The E2E Bridge is undoubtedly a new approach to an old problem that goes beyond many of the visual integration mechanisms on the market, which can be superficially graphical but still require coding to wire applications together, by adding the element of executing the model without code."
